Taking the reference of the Honorable Supreme Court direction on 23<sup>rd</sup> March, 2020. The honorable court had directed all states and Union Territories to set up 'High Level Committees' to determine the class of #prisoners who could be released on parole for four to six weeks. It also observed that the prisoners convicted of or charged with offences having jail term of up to seven years can be given parole to decongest jails.
