

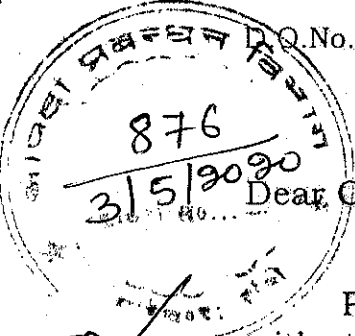

Please refer to my D.O. letter of even number dated 02.04.2020 with the request to take necessary measures to ensure smooth disbursement of money to the beneficiaries of Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Yojana (PM-GKY). As you are aware, under the PM-GKY package, disbursement of 2<sup>nd</sup> tranche of DBT transfers to large number of beneficiaries will take place from tomorrow. In this regard, the Department of Financial Services, Ministry of Finance has given detailed guidelines such as staggering of account holders to avoid crowding and maintaining social distancing; publicizing the modalities of staggering and cash distribution; and provision of adequate security personnel at bank branches and business correspondents (BCs) to maintain law and order and social distancing. A copy of DFS's letter dated 1<sup>st</sup> May 2020 in this regard is enclosed.

2. The concerned Departments of the State Government/UT Administration, District authorities and field agencies may please be informed on the above for strict compliance. They shall take all necessary measures to ensure smooth disbursement of money to the beneficiaries of PM-GKY. An action taken report may please be sent to the Ministry.

**Subject: Disbursement of DBT money for women account holders of Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana (PMJDY) under Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Yojana (PM-GKY) package**

Dear Sir,

This is in continuation to the Department of Financial Services (DFS) Letter of even number dated 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2020 on the captioned subject, wherein the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) was requested to write to all the Chief Secretaries of States / UTs regarding provision of adequate security personnel by local administrations to banks for maintenance of law and order and smooth disbursal of money to the beneficiaries of PM-GKY. Accordingly, MHA had written to all States / UTs vide Letter dated 2<sup>nd</sup> April, 2020.

2. As the month of May has now approached, the second tranche of DBT transfers to the accounts of women beneficiaries is now required to be done. As before, staggering of DBT credit to the beneficiaries will be done based on the last digit of the account number of the beneficiaries and SMS's will be sent to those beneficiaries whose mobile number is seeded in the account. SMSs will also indicate the day on which the beneficiary has to come to bank branches /BCs for withdrawal of the money. The arrangements will be as under

Dates for withdrawal	4 <sup>th</sup> May	5 <sup>th</sup> May	6 <sup>th</sup> May	8 <sup>th</sup> May	11 <sup>th</sup> May
Account No ending with	0 or 1	2 or 3	4 or 5	6 or 7	8 or 9

3. In this regard, States/ UTs will be required to provide necessary administrative including police support/ adequate security personnel at bank branches/ BCs/ ATMs for staggering the crowd for maintenance of law and order and social distancing, while beneficiaries come to bank branches/ BCs/ ATMs, in coordination with SLBC conveners and Zonal/ Regional heads of banks (at the State Level) and in coordination with Lead

Managers of the District Level Bankers Committee and local heads of banks (at District Level). As before, with the help of the local administration, banks will publicize the above modalities of staggering of withdrawal of money by the beneficiaries through local Channels/ Print Media/ cable operators/ local radio/ other channels. Bank branches should also be allowed to work as per normal working hours till the time disbursement of DBT money is complete.

4. As mentioned above, with regard to the upcoming second tranche of DBT transfers to the accounts of women beneficiaries in May 2020, I have been directed to request you to kindly write to the Chief Secretaries of all States/ UTs, as was done by MHA vide Letter dated 2<sup>nd</sup> April, 2020, to provide adequate security personnel and coordinate with banks as mentioned in Paras 2 and 3 above.
