Sub: General Administration Department- COVID-19- lock down to contain the disease- interstate movement of persons stranded due to lock down-reg.

Ref: Order No. 40-3/2020-DM-I (A) dated 15.04.2020 and 29.04.2020 of MHA, Government of India

As you are aware, the Ministry of Home Affairs in its order dated 29.04.2020 has permitted the interstate of travel of migrant workers, pilgrims, tourists, students and other persons who are stranded due to lock down after following the guidelines specified therein. Accordingly this State Government has decided to bring back the persons hailing from Kerala who are stranded in other States and would like return to their home urgently and to allow the persons who would like to go back to other States. We have already started registration through an online portal to know the persons who would like to come back and have designated nodal officers to coordinate with their counterparts in each State (copy of government order enclosed). As per the registration portal, 299 persons stranded in your State has expressed their desire to come back immediately to Kerala. They will be issued with an e pass with QR code from our portal to undertake the journey and reach the designated check posts from tomorrow onwards. We are making elaborate arrangements in the entry check posts for mandatory health checkups and other related formalities.


